# Forthcoming protocol amendment

We have recently submitted Substantial Amendment 5 to REC/HRA which will include a number of protocol changes:

- We will be **removing the Reduced Consent option** and, in turn, we plan to withdraw participants who were recruited to this consent option. We will be in touch with sites about the process of withdrawing participants once the amendment has been approved.
- We will be removing the Demographics for Decliners form and replacing it with a Decliners Log. The Decliners Log will collect, as a tally, 3-4 demographic details of those who have declined to participate: Gender (for the NHL cohort), Age (in years), cancer number/FIGO stage and ECOG performance status.
- We recognise that some sites will be sending documents to patients in advance of their appointment and so the Site Invitation Letter will be changing to indicate that research teams may contact eligible patients over the telephone.
- We have **changed the questionnaire time points:** Participants will now complete questionnaires at Baseline (pre-treatment), 3 months, 12 months, 18 months, 24 months and then annually after.

This amendment will also include the 12 month follow-up questionnaire, which will be sent to participants via the HORIZONS Co-ordinating Centre.

You will have the opportunity to review this amendment after HRA categorisation but please do get in touch if you have any questions about any of these forthcoming changes.

## Questionnaire return rates

HORIZONS is very pleased to report a continued high rate of baseline questionnaire completion and return (the average across all cohorts is 82%). It is encouraging to see that our participants are highly engaged! Below is a breakdown across the cohorts:
